Adventure Development Counselling (age 13-19) is a longer-term program that can offer support to young people wanting more intensive support with mental health or alcohol or drug concerns. It is only internally referred – please speak to an ADL (Adventure Development Ltd) staff member if this interests you or you want to know more. ADC has a focus in using activity and outdoor experiences to help develop new skills to better manage challenging times. Young people on ADC will attend counselling sessions, day activities and may be offered a 4–9-day journey. We also offer a marae-based journey. No charge for services.
